Children's Museum of Pittsburgh Partners with Western Pennsylvania To Offer One Free Adult Admission for Donors

Bring a 20-count of any size diapers to the museum in August and receive one free adult or senior admission

PITTSBURGH, PA (August 1, 2024) – Children's Museum of Pittsburgh is excited to host its second annual diaper drive for the Western Pennsylvania Diaper Bank throughout the month of August to benefit children and families in the region.

Visitors who drop off one or more unopened 20-count or larger pack of diapers (any size) during August will receive one free adult or senior Children's Museum admission. The free admission must be used on the day you make your diaper donation and visitors are limited to one free admission per transaction. This offer is not valid with any other discounts and is not transferrable.

"It's so important to support early childhood-related causes and by raising awareness and providing supplies, you can directly help families while also enjoying a day of innovative and inclusive experiences at the museum," said Max Pipman, Children's Museum Sr. Director of Communications.

Last year the museum collected more than 27,000 diapers and is anticipating a great turnout this year. Visitors can participate from 10:00 – 5:00 pm at Children's Museum of Pittsburgh.

The Western Pennsylvania Diaper Bank partners with dozens of social services organizations to distribute diapers and other products to families in need. The diaper bank is the region's only basic-needs bank and has distributed more than 6.8 million diapers to the community since 2012.

Visitors can explore the Museum's temporary exhibit, *How People Make Things*, which tells the story of how people, ideas and technology transform raw materials into finished products. Based on the factory video tours of the *Mister Rogers' Neighborhood* television show, visitors can try out simple manufacturing processes using real tools and materials. Permanent hands-on exhibits to also explore include the Art Studio, Garage, Waterplay, Kindness Gallery, Backyard and MAKESHOP®. Visitors can also visit MuseumLab, which is open most of August from noon – 5:00 pm - check museumlab.org for the latest hours.
