*Museum Voted #2 in USA Today 10Best Readers' Choice Awards*

PITTSBURGH, PA (February 19, 2025) – Children's Museum of Pittsburgh is proud to announce that it placed second in the 2025 USA Today 10Best Readers' Choice Awards for best children's museum in the country.

"We are incredibly appreciative to be acknowledged for our innovative and inclusive work once again as one of the leading children's museums in the country," said Max Pipman, Senior Director of Communications for Children's Museum of Pittsburgh. "This recognition is a reflection of the passion and dedication of our entire team who are committed to creating joyful experiences that enrich the lives of our visitors."

This is the sixth consecutive year that the Children's Museum placed in the top ten in the USA Today 10Best Reader's Choice Awards, including landing the #2 spot for the third year in a row. Children's Museum of Pittsburgh welcomed more than 350,000 visitors last year to explore its interactive exhibits and attend regularly rotating programs, activities and events. Its two historic buildings plus MuseumLab, where kids 10+ can have cutting-edge experiences in art, tech and making in a neighboring building, and Buhl Community Park make up the nation's largest cultural campus for kids.

Visitors can now immerse themselves in the Museum's newest exhibit, I AM WILD: A Charley Harper Exhibit, inspired by the iconic artwork of Charley Harper and his distinctive style of "minimal realism." Explore vibrant depictions of birds, animals and insects across six habitats and uncover the diversity and interdependency of life in the natural world.
